THE TOUR INCLUDED INSPECTION OF THE HILES MILL POND, PINE CREEK, THE DAM AT THE SOUTH END OF THE LAKE AND SEVERAL SHORE LINE PROPERTIES, WHERE LARGE AMOUNTS OF WEEDS AND DEBRIS WERE PILED UP DUE TO THE NEGLECT OF PROPERTY OWNERS TO CLEAN THEIR SHORES.

THE BOARD WILL MEET SOON WITH SCOTT HENDRICKSON, COUNTY RESOURCE AGENT, TO OBTAIN MORE INFORMATION ON SUBMITTING AN APPLICATION TO THE DERT. OF NATURAL RESOURCES FOR TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE IN DESIGNING A FEASIBILITY STUDY FOR PINE LAKE.

THE PINE LAKE PROTECTIVE AND REHABILITATION DISTRICT BOARD MET ON AUGUST 27, 1975, AT THE HILES TOWN HALL. SCOTT HENDRICKSON LED DISCUSSION RELATING TO RULES, REGULATIONS, AND DATA NECESSARY TO BE GATHERED TO SEND TO THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES IN ORDER TO APPLY FOR TECHNICAL AID.

THE SECRETARY WAS APPOINTED TO WRITE TO VARIOUS STATE AGENCIES FOR DATA RELATING TO PINE LAKE AND ANY PREVIOUS STUDIES MADE. GLEN VOTIS WILL PROVIDE DETAILED MAPS OF THE LAKE, SHOWING LOCATIONS OF PROPERTY OWNERS AND PUBLIC ACCESSES. SCOTT HENDRICKSON WILL CONTACT BOB STARETT, A STATE HYDROLOGIST, FOR OTHER NECESSARY INFORMATION NEEDED.

RON KRUEGER EXPLAINED WHAT IS INVOLVED IN DOING A FEASIBILITY STUDY AND SAID THAT PROPERTY OWNERS COULD VOLUNTEER THEIR SERVICES IN HELPING COLLECT DATA, THEREBY LOWERING THE COST OF THE STUDY TO THE DISTRICT.

IT WAS POINTED OUT THAT ONE MEMBER COULD NOT BE BOTH SECRETARY AND TRESURER OF THE DISTRICT, SO THE NEW TRESURER OF THE DISTRICT WAS APPOINTED, WHO IS MRS. RAYMOND KENT.

LOIS BUICK MADE A MOTION TO APPLY FOR TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE IN DESIGNING A FEASIBILITY STUDY FOR PINE LAKE, TO THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES. THE MOTION WAS SECONDED BY WILLIAM BLAEDOW.

NOTICE OF THE ANNUAL MEETING SHOULD BE PUBLISHED IN THE NEWSPAPER THREE TIMES PRECEDING THE MEETING, AND ALL PROPERTY OWNERS SHOULD BE NOTIFIED THREE WEEKS BEFOR THE MEETING.

A LIST OF PROPERTY OWNERS IS TO BE OBTAINED BY THE SECRETARY , FROM THE TOWN TREASURER.

IT WAS SUGGESTED THAT A NEWSLETTER BE SENT TO THE PROPERTY OWNERS AT A FUTURE DATE TO KEEP THEM INFORMED OF WHAT IS HAPPENING IN REGARD TO THE DISTRICT.

MARCH 8, 1976

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, OF THE PINE LAKE PROTECTION AND REHABILITATION DISTRICT, MET AT THE HILES TOWN HALL, AT 1:00 P. M. ON MARCH 8, 1976, WITH THE FOREST COUNTY, UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN EXTENSION AGENT, SCOTT HENDRICKSON.

THE PURPOSE OF THIS MEETING WAS TO STUDY THE BIDS, RECEIVED FROM THE EIGHT, LAKE MANAGEMENT CONSULTING FIRMS, TO CONDUCT A FEASIBILITY STUDY, OF PINE LAKE, WHICH HAD BEEN DESIGNED BY THE WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES.

AFTER A STUDY AND DISCUSSION OF THE COST PROPOSALS SUBMITTED BY THE VARIOUS FIRMS, A VOTE WAS TAKEN WITH UNANIMOUS APPROVAL OF THE BOARD MEMBERS TO ACCEPT THE FIRM BID OF NORTHERN LAKE SERVICE, OF \$18,838.50.

THE SECRETARY WAS ADVISED TO SEND THE APPLICATION FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, WHICH WAS MAILED ON MARCH 9, 1976. IN THE APPLICATION, THE BOARD REQUESTED 60% OF THE TOTAL COST OF THE FEASIBILITY STUDY WHICH AMOUNTED TO \$11,303.00. THE DISTRICT'S SHARE WILL BE 40% OF THE TOTAL BID AMOUNTING TO \$7535.40. POTENTIAL IN-KIND WORK AMOUNTING TO \$5913.50 DONE BY THE PINE LAKE DISTRICT MEMBERS, COULD REDUCE THE DISTRICT'S SHARE, TO \$1621.90.

A LETTER WAS SENT TO NORTHERN LAKE SERVICE, INFORMING THEM OF THE BOARD'S DECISION TO AWARD THE CONTRACT TO THEM, TO CONDUCT THE FEASIBILITY STUDY,

A GENERAL INFORMATION MEETING AND PROGRESS REPORT WILL BE HELD IN APRIL, AT THE HILES TOWN HALL WITH ALL PROPERTY OWNERS TO BE NOTIFIED TWO WEEKS IN ADVANCE OF THE MEETING.

IT WAS SUGGESTED THAT WE REQUEST DONATIONS FROM DISTRICT PROPERTY OWNERS TO HELP PAY THE COST OF STATIONERY AND STAMPS, NEEDED TO CONDUCT THE CORRESPONDENCE NECESSARY TO THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE DISTRICT.

A NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING OF PINE LAKE PROTECTION & REHABILITATION DISTRICT WAS GIVEN TO BE HELD IN OPEN SESSION ON AUGUST 20TH 1984 AT 10: A.M. AT THE HILES TOWN HALL. THIS PUBLIC MEETING WAS TO CONSIDER THE PETITION OF JOHN TAUER FOR DETACHMENT FROM THE DISTRICT.

THE MEETING OPENED AT 10: A.M. WITH LAKE COMMISSIONERS SCHUBEL, KERR, & SIKORA. ^{PRESENT:} ARVIN WILKER TOWN COMMISSIONER WAS ALSO PRESENT. COUNTY COMMISSIONER HUETL WAS PROPERLY NOTICED BUT WAS NOT PRESENT. REPRESENTING THE LAKE DISTRICT WAS ATTORNEY TIM KORT. THIS MEETING WAS ALSO ATTENDED BY 8 OTHER INTERESTED PARTIES.

WE THEN MADE A MOTION TO GO BACK INTO OPEN SESSION TO GIVE JOHN TAUER THE COURTESY OF HEARING HIS REASONS FOR DETACHMENT. JOHN TAUER STATED HIS MAIN REASON FOR DETACHMENT WAS THAT BEING ON THE EAST SIDE OF HY. 32 HAS NO BENEFIT TO PINE LAKE, AND THAT HE HAS NEVER BENEFITED BY HAVING PINE LAKE $\frac{1}{4}$ OF A MILE FROM HIS HOME. HE ALSO STATED NEIGHBORS AROUND HIM WERE NOT IN THE LAKE DISTRICT. MR. TAUER WAS REMINDING THAT WHENEVER NEW PROGRAMS ARE ESTABLISHED TO DO WITH AREA'S WHETHER IT BE TOWNSHIPS LAKE DISTRICTS OR WHATEVER, BOUNDARIES MUST BE FORMED, AND WHEN THIS IS DONE LEGALLY & ACCORDING TO STATE STATUTES ON BOUNDARIES THESE AREAS ARE THEN LEGALLY RECORDED.

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JOHN TAVER WAS ASKED IF HE HAD ANY MORE REASONS FOR DETACHMENT AND HE STATED THESE WERE HIS MAIN ONES.
